My Teaching Philosophy

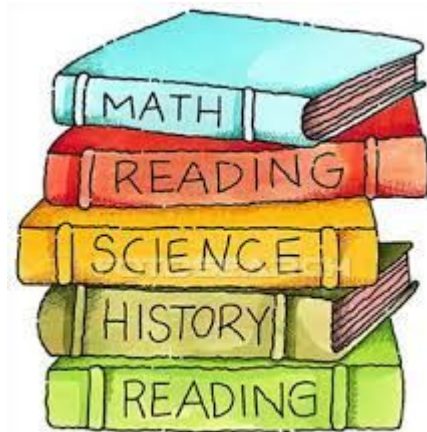
My teaching philosophy is to first foster an environment where students feel respected and comfortable. From there I aim to meet each child where they are so that they can grow and thrive academically.
